 CHILDHOOD SUCCESS	Mobilize families and other community residents to advocate for increased resources (reading specialists, afterschool and summer programming, and volunteer tutors) at low-income schools that serve disproportionate numbers of children not reading on grade level.

IMPACT AREA	SAMPLE ACTIVITIES
 YOUTH SUCCESS	Mobilize families to advocate for increased student access to advanced coursework (Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate programs), test preparation programs, college awareness, and career support at schools that predominantly serve students of color and/or low-income students. In low-performing schools, work with parents/families to ensure that they have representation on school improvement teams.

IMPACT AREA	SAMPLE ACTIVITIES
 <p>ECONOMIC MOBILITY</p>	<p>Convene community forums to share data on current disparities in homeownership and understand their origins in historical patterns of lending discrimination and redlining. Help residents consider the long-term impact on family net worth and mobilize them to advocate for solutions to address housing inequities.</p>

 <p>ACCESS TO HEALTH</p>	<p>Organize focus groups of women of color to understand experiences with pre and post-natal medical treatment; share these findings with community-based health providers and partners.</p>
